

DGCA Student Pilot Training Courses

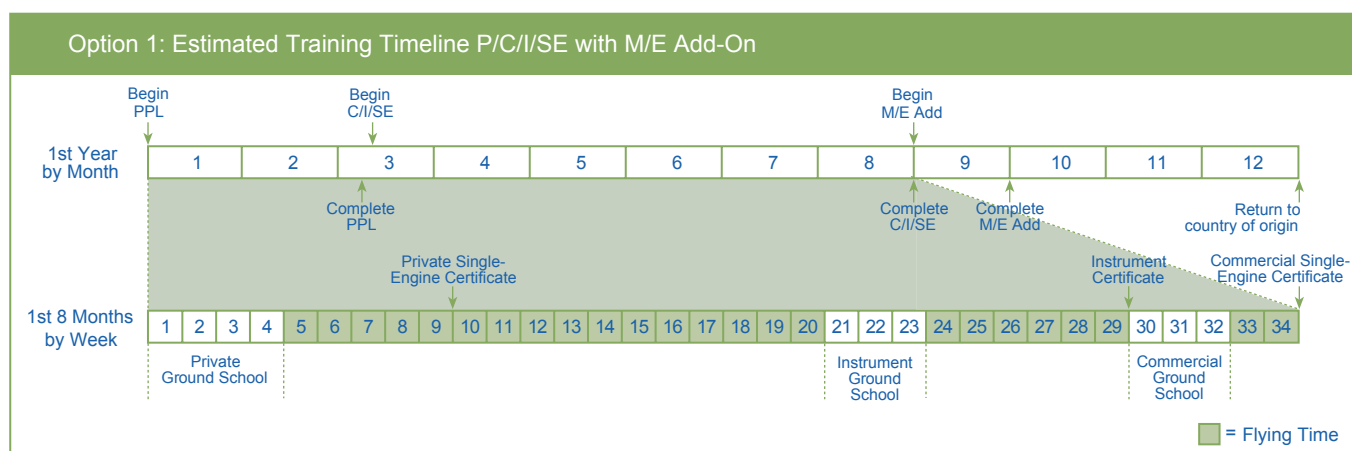
For International Students on a M-1 Visa

The following is a description of the pilot training courses offered by FlightSafety Academy for the international student who want to convert to DGCA standards. An M-1 visa is required for participation in these courses.

Course Description

The course outlined here includes the licenses required for commercial flight. These will be earned through a combination of ground school (academic class), simulator time and flying time in the aircraft. With an M-1 visa, you are permitted to take courses for up to one year. After the one-year term, you will return to your home country.

You will begin with the Private Pilot's License (PPL) and then earn your Commercial and Instrument licenses in the Single-Engine aircraft (C/I/SE). Additionally, you may add on your Commercial Multi-Engine rating (M/E).
