The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs approves FlightSafety Academy for the continuing education of eligible veterans under Chapters 30, 1606 and 1607 of the Veterans' Education Program.

VA BENEFIT CLASSIFICATIONS

Chapter 30

Chapter 30 benefits relate to those that have honorably served active duty and made a \$1200 contribution to the Montgomery GI Bill. FlightSafety Academy will require a complete copy of your Form DD-214.

Chapter 1606

Chapter 1606 benefits relate to those that made a six-year commitment to the Selected Reserves / National Guard.

Chapter 1607

Chapter 1607 gives those that were activated after September 11, 2001 either eligibility for education benefits or eligibility for increased benefits. It is known as the Reserve Education Assistance Program.

Benefits and Qualifications

The VA will reimburse 60 percent of the cost of dual and solo flight, dual simulator training, pre- and post-flight briefing, and academic training up to the maximum allowed by the VA for each course.

- Commercial Pilot Training Courses (above the Private Pilot level)
- Multi-Engine Class Ratings
- Flight Instructor Ratings
- Airline Transport Pilot Certificate
- Advanced Airline Training Program
