

Veterans Education Benefits

FlightSafety Academy has been a U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs approved flight training school since 1970. Veterans may utilize their Chapters 33 (Post 9/11), 30, 1606, and 1607 education benefits to attend the Academy. For eligibility and maximum entitlement questions, please contact www.gibill.va.gov.

All benefit classifications require the Veteran to hold at least a Private Pilot's License, a first or second class FAA Medical Certificate, and a copy of your certificate of eligibility.

Chapter 33 Post 9/11

Active duty Veterans that honorably served after September 11, 2001, and did not contribute to the Montgomery GI Bill, the maximum reimbursement of \$13,526.81 within an academic year (August 1 through July 31) for a total of \$52,126.44. The reimbursement cap applies to all classes and/or enrollments that begin during that academic year, regardless of the academic year in which the class or enrollments are completed. This is based on the Veteran meeting 100% eligibility.

Chapter 30 - Montgomery Bill

For those that honorably served active duty and made a \$1,200.00 contribution to the Montgomery GI Bill before leaving active duty, present maximum reimbursement equals 60% of the approved cost of the course. This classification will reimburse 60% of the cost of approved dual and solo flight, dual simulator, pre and post flight briefings, and academic training up to the maximum allowed by the VA for each course. FAA written tests are reimbursed at 100%.

Chapter 1607

For those that were Selected Reservists activated after September 11, 2001, and continue actively drilling, present maximum reimbursement equals 48% of the approved cost of courses. This classification will reimburse 60% of the cost of approved dual and solo flight, dual simulator, pre and post flight briefings, and academic training up to the maximum allowed by the VA for each course. FAA written tests are reimbursed at 100%.
